INSTRUCTIONS

1. The District Executive Leadership Award evaluation form must be completed in September and sent with all documentation requested to the district RR director (with the exception of the district director's application) postmarked on or before September 30 each year.
2. The district director's application must be sent in (with same deadlines above) to the national office for approval and processing. The district director's application will not be processed without completion of the annual trends report required by the National Royal Rangers Ministries office.
3. The points recorded on the evaluation sheets must represent those earned September 1-August 31 except when notated by star (*).
4. Recognition will be given to the member during the annual district conference.

CRITERIA: The following are the minimum requisites to receive the District Executive Leadership Award:

1. The District Executive Leadership Award is limited to district executive committee members (varies from district to district, but typically includes: district director, outreach coordinator, training coordinator, communications coordinator, and FCF president.)
2. The applicant must consistently wear a clean and professional looking Royal Rangers uniform.
3. The applicant must earn at least 300 points using the evaluation sheet from each of the following three evaluation categories below:
 - Advancement & Training: 80 points minimum
 - Leadership Responsibilities: 100 points minimum
 - Local Responsibilities: 120 points minimum

CATEGORY DESCRIPTIONS

Advancement/Training

1. Earn 5 points for each completed level.
2. Earn 8 points for each for each time you personally taught or served on staff at a national Royal Rangers leadership training event (National Ranger Ministry Camp, World Class Outpost, and National Elementary Education Conference/RKTC).
3. Earn 5 points for each time you taught Ranger Basics or Ranger Essentials.
4. Earn 2 points for each continuous learning opportunity completed/taught.
5. Earn 20 points if you have earned the Medal of Excellence.
6. Earn 15 points for each leaders training track you have completed.
7. Earn 5 points each for each FCF advancement completed.
8. Earn 5 points for each training academy (formerly ICS; also includes National Academy and Advanced Academy) you attended or taught.
9. Earn 10 points for attending the Johnnie Barnes Excellence in Leadership and Ministry Initiative. Good for 5 years from date of attendance.

Leadership Responsibilities

10. Earn 20 points if you participated in the annual district camp.
11. Earn 5 points for each district Royal Rangers event attended (including training events) not previously counted.
12. Earn 5 points for each division/section event attended.
13. Earn 10 points for each junior training camp at which you served on staff.
14. Earn 20 points if you attended National RR Conference (LEAD).
15. Earn 5 points for each national or regional event attended (including training events) not previously counted.
16. Earn 5 points for each district/section staff meeting attended.
17. Earn 20 points for giving to RRI through local church or for being a RRI Task Force Member.
18. Earn 10 point for each national or district AG activity attended. (*i.e.*, General or District Council, National or District Fine Arts Festival, National Children's Ministries Conference, etc.)
19. Earn 10 points for each missions project participated in. (*Approved projects are, RRI, BGMC Master's Toolbox, PathFinders Missions, and STL Christmas Project.*)
20. Earn 5 points for each district/division/section service project participated in.

Local Participation

21. Earn 5 points for being a member of a chartered outpost.
22. Earn 10 points each time you present RR to pastors and/or congregation currently without RR.
23. Earn 5 points for each new church that chartered in your district during the past year.
24. Earn 5 points for every leader completing the National Ranger Ministry Camp or National Elementary Education Conference. Earn 1 point for every leader completing World Class Outpost.
25. Earn 5 points for every leader completing the Ready level (Ranger Basics, Ranger Essentials and the Ready Ticket) of the Outpost Leader Advancement level.
26. Earn 5 points for holding a current instructor certification. A current Instructor Certification is required for all leaders who also complete National Academy, Advanced Academy and who are Academy Instructors. All instructors for the Rangers Ministry Academy must recertify through the Training Academy every 5 years.
27. Earn 2 points for each instance of ministry to local groups outside your local church (includes all ceremonies).
28. Earn 10 points for regularly communicating to leaders in your district, including district web site, newsletters, or emails.)
29. Earn 1 point for each boy you personally led to Christ during the past year.
